## CLEAN YOUR WADERS TO PROTECT NJ TROUT STREAMS

### INSPECT

your gear carefully  
Snails hide in treads  
& socks

### TREAT

Remove debris  
Rinse with  
potable water

### DRY

waders  
completely

Avoid using felt  
soled waders

Dry for 72 hours before  
using in other streams
